2 Audition pieces required - Contrasting monologues (must be from a play), 1 contemporary and 1 Shakespeare, or 2 Contemporary (1 dramatic and 1 comedic). Each piece should be no longer than 2 minutes; applicant should know both monologues without use of text (on paper or computer). In person audition is preferred, followed by an interview; we will accept videotaped auditions which will be followed by a Skype Interview.

O Broadcasting for Web, Radio & TV

Successful completion of a vocal audition and personal interview (either in-person or by phone). Applicants must showcase high proficiency in general broadcasting knowledge, industry awareness, and the English language.

Letter of Intent

A one page personal statement describing: your career goals, what sparks your interest for your chosen program of study and why you have chosen VanArts.
