Acting for Film & TV

2 Audition pieces required - Contrasting monologues (must be from a play), 1 contemporary and 1 Shakespeare, or 2 Contemporary (1 dramatic and 1 comedic). Each piece should be no longer than 2 minutes; applicant should know both monologues without use of text (on paper or computer). In person audition is preferred, followed by an interview; we will accept recorded auditions which will be followed by a Skype Interview.
